- When you register for 3 or more weeks of camp, you receive complimentary Open Gym every Friday.

Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement for Summer Camp

In consideration of participating in the CORE Kids Academy Program, I represent that I understand the nature of this Activity and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I acknowledge that if I believe event conditions are unsafe, I will immediately discontinue participation in the Activity. I fully understand that this Activity involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the event, the condition in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the "releasees" named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, cost, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue CORE Kids Academy, LLC, its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages, on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and future agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost, which any may incur as the result of such claim.

I have read the Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

IMPORTANT! Please read...

Dismissal Procedure

We make every effort to make the dismissal process a speedy one. However, to ensure the safety of every camper, we ask that you follow this process carefully. We thank you for your patience and understanding with this matter.

- Upon arrival, please enter through the door on the left and check in at the front desk.
- Your child cannot be released until you are checked in at the front desk.
- Once you have been checked in, please gather your child's belongings and wait in the party room to help your camper pack up.
- Many campers can get upset or distracted when they start to see parents arriving. This can often slow down the dismissal process significantly. We ask your cooperation in not interacting with campers until they are dismissed to the lobby. We appreciate adults waiting by the doors rather than waiting at the green ledge between the lobby and gym.
- At NO TIME should you take your child out of the gym without following this process. Younger campers especially may get upset upon seeing their adult and not being able to go to them. We will make every effort to give upset children priority at dismissal, but still ask for your vigilance in allowing us to safely dismiss every camper rather than reaching over the gate to grab them.
- Children will be dismissed in order of their adult's arrival.
- Children will only be dismissed to the adult who signed them in unless otherwise noted. EVERYONE must bring a photo ID when picking children up.
- Children will be dismissed in small groups, regardless of how many adults are waiting.
- If the lobby appears to be full, please wait outside of the building until it clears out a bit before entering.
- Please exit from the door furthest from the front desk and only with the child(ren) that you signed out.
- NEVER allow a child to walk out of the door with you unless they are yours. We appreciate your careful attention on this.
